The Mayor called the second regular November 2013 meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to order. Present were Mayor Gene F. McGee, Alderman D. I. Smith, Alderman Wesley Hamlin, Alderman Chuck Gautier, Alderman Ken Heard, Alderman Scott Jones, Alderman Kevin Holder, City Attorney James Gabriel, City Attorney Jerry Mills, and City Clerk Paula Tierce. Absent was Alderman Brian Ramsey. The meeting was opened with an invocation by Alderman Scott Jones followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen were provided the November 2013 Sales Tax Report and the October 2013 Financial Report.

Next came the matter of accepting the Minutes of the November 4, 2013 Work Session and the November 5, 2013 Mayor and Board of Aldermen Meeting. The Minutes were accepted with no corrections noted.

(Alderman Brian Ramsey entered the meeting)

Next came the request of Gateway Rescue Mission for consideration of a conditional use permit for retail in a C-5 zoning district. Community Development Director Alan Hart informed the Mayor and Board of Alderman that Gateway Rescue Mission had met one through fourteen requirements of section 600.09.D of the Zoning Ordinance and finding fifteen could be met by adhering to the following conditions: (a) make improvements to existing landscape and lighting subject to the ARB approval process; (b) install a gate to prohibit access during close hours with gate including a sign that deters donation drop offs at the gate during closed hours; (c) pain the building front with approved Northpark Overlay District colors subject to the ARB approval process; (d) prohibit outdoor sales, display, and/or storage; (e) provide measures as necessary to control loitering and donation drop offs during closed hours; (f) use a channel letter, internally illuminated or not, sign with letters being individually mounted to building; (g) prohibit the parking of delivery vehicles displaying signage within the front yard area as defined by the Zoning Ordinance; (h) prohibit from operating a soup kitchen or housing location; (i) limit hours of operation from 9am to 6pm Monday through Saturday; and (j) install a black aluminum rail fence along the south side of the property to improve the security between properties subject to the ARB approval process. Alderman Scott Jones moved to grant the conditional use permit subject to the following conditions being met by Gateway Rescue Mission: (a) make improvements to existing landscape and lighting subject to the ARB approval process; (b) install a gate to prohibit access during close hours with gate including a sign that deters donation drop offs at the gate during closed hours; (c) pain the building front with approved Northpark Overlay District colors subject to the ARB approval process; (d) prohibit outdoor sales, display, and/or storage; (e) provide measures as necessary to control loitering and donation drop offs during closed hours; (f) use a channel letter, internally illuminated or not, sign with letters being individually mounted to building; (g) prohibit the parking of delivery vehicles displaying signage within the front yard area as defined by the Zoning Ordinance; (h) prohibit from operating a soup kitchen or housing location; (i) limit hours of operation from 9am to 6pm Monday through Saturday; and (j) install a black aluminum rail fence along the south side of the property to improve the security between properties subject to the ARB approval process. ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE TOWNSHIP AT COLONY PARK
TRADITIONAL NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT OVERLAY DISTRICT
ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIDGELAND, MISSISSIPPI

WHEREAS, The Township at Colony Park Tradition Neighborhood Development Overlay District Ordinance of the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi (the “Ordinance”) was adopted as of August 7, 2001 and revised amended June 11, 2003, and December 20, 2006 and August 7, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, the Petitioner, The Township Land Company, LLC, a Mississippi limited liability company, has petitioned the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to amend certain sections of the Ordinance to accommodate changes that have occurred in the area since the last revision amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides that these amendments can be made by petition to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen; and,

WHEREAS, public notice announcing a public hearing for the purpose of determining whether to amend the Township at Colony Park Traditional Neighborhood Development Overlay District Ordinance as amended was published on November __, 2013, in the *Madison County Journal* in the same manner as required for a zoning change; and

WHEREAS, at 6:00 o’clock p.m. on December 3, 2013, the time, date and place specified in the notice the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi did consider the Petition filed by The Township Land Company, LLC, as Petitioner, and conduct a full and complete discussion public hearing and hereby find that it would be in the best interest of the City, the Petitioner and the future land use planning of the City that the Ordinance be amended as set out hereinafter; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen are familiar with the property which makes up the Overlay District and the existing land uses within the City of Ridgeland and in acting on an Ordinance, have fully considered the matters and facts within their personal knowledge which affect the land uses involved; and,

WHEREAS, having considered all the facts and discussions made, and after further discussion thereof, Alderman _____ offered the following Ordinance and moved that it be adopted, to-wit:

Section I

That the matters and facts stated in the preamble hereof are found to be true and correct.

Section II

The Ordinance is hereby amended to include within the Township Central District rather than within the Township North District, all as defined in Section V of the Ordinance, that certain property which is known as Block E of The Township at Colony Park, Part 2 as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" attached to the Petition hereto, and further, the Ordinance is hereby amended to substitute in full place and stead for the Proposed Master Plan, designated as The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, and to replace the same with The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, revised October 8, 2013, which is attached to the Petition hereto as Exhibit "B"; provided however, as to Block E only, the Land Uses Permitted, as specified in Section V (A) of the TND Overlay District Ordinance shall not include freestanding enclosed restaurants in accordance with the

Official Zoning Ordinance which may include allowance for adjacent outdoor dining as specified in Section V(A) 21 thereof.

Section III

The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, revised October 8, 2013 attached as Exhibit "B" to the Petition hereto, is hereby adopted as the current Proposed Master Plan of the Ordinance.

Section III IV

The Ordinance shall be, and the same is hereby amended to reflect the foregoing changes in the text of the Ordinance from and after thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by this Board.

WHEREAS, the Petitioner, Ridgeland Hotel Group, LLC, through its authorized representative, The Township Land Company, LLC, has petitioned the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to amend certain sections of the Ordinance to accommodate changes that have occurred in the area since the last revision amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides that these amendments can be made by petition to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen; and,

WHEREAS, public notice announcing a public hearing for the purpose of determining whether to amend the Township at Colony Park Traditional Neighborhood Development Overlay District Ordinance was published November ____ 2013, in the *Madison County Journal* in the same manner as required for a zoning change; and

Section I

That the matters and facts stated in the preamble hereof are found to be true and correct.

Section II

The legal description of the Subject Area as set forth in the Ordinance is hereby amended to include within the Subject Area the Annexed Property, as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" to the Petition attached hereto.

Section III

The Ordinance is hereby amended to substitute in full place and stead for the location map designated as EXHIBIT “B” – LOCATION MAP OF SUBJECT AREA, of the Ordinance and to replace the same with the location map which includes the Annexed Property designated as EXHIBIT “B” - LOCATION MAP OF SUBJECT AREA REVISED TO INCLUDE Annexed Property, revised October 10, 2013, which is attached to the Petition hereto as Exhibit “B”. Further, the Ordinance is hereby amended to include the Annexed Property within the Township South District, as defined in Section V of the Ordinance, and to substitute in full place and stead for The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, and replace the same with The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, revised October 10, 2013, which is attached to the Petition hereto as Exhibit “C”.

IV

The Township at Colony Park Proposed Master Plan dated August 7, 2001, revised October 10, 2013 attached as Exhibit “C” to the Petition hereto, is hereby adopted as the current Proposed Master Plan of the Ordinance.

Section IV

The Ordinance shall be, and the same is hereby amended to reflect the foregoing changes in the text of the Ordinance from and after thirty (30) days from the date of adoption by this Board.

**AN ORDINANCE ENLARGING, EXTENDING AND DEFINING THE
CORPORATE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF
RIDGELAND, MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE
CITY OF RIDGELAND, MISSISSIPPI:**

SECTION 1. Public convenience and necessity requiring the same, that the corporate boundaries and limits of the City of Ridgeland, Madison County, Mississippi, be and the same are hereby extended and enlarged so as to embrace the following adjacent unincorporated lands and territory in Madison County, Mississippi, to-wit:

2013 ANNEXATION AREA A

Being a part of the Northeast 1/4 and the Southeast 1/4 of Section 15, Township 7 North, Range 1 East, Madison County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the Northeast corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the said Northeast 1/4 of Section 15, and run South 00° 13' 35" West for a distance of 86.36 feet along the Eastern line of the said Section 15 to the Southern right of way line of Lake Castle Road and the **POINT OF BEGINNING** for the parcel herein described, said point lying on the present corporate limits of the City of Ridgeland; thence following said corporate limits continue South 00° 13' 35" West for a distance of 2,559.80 feet along the said Eastern line of Section 15 to an iron pin; thence South 89° 08' 32" West for a distance of 978.69 feet along the Northern line, and a Westerly extension thereof, of Bridgewater Seven, a subdivision, the map or plat of which is recorded in the Chancery Records of Madison County at Canton, Mississippi; thence leaving said corporate limits run North 00° 26' 44" West for a distance of 1,334.00 feet to an iron pin which marks the Northern line of the Northeast 1/4 of the said Southeast 1/4 of Section 15; thence North 89° 40' 06" East for a distance of 662.64 feet along the Northern line of the said Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 15 to an iron pin; thence leave said Northern line and run North 00° 12' 55" East for a distance of 931.59 feet; thence South 89° 54' 00" East for a distance of 301.73 feet; thence North 00° 13' 35" East for a distance of 300.85 feet to the said Southern right of way line of Lake Castle Road; thence run 30.39 feet along the arc of a 1,251.38 foot radius curve to the left along the said Southern right of way line, said arc having a 30.39 foot chord which bears North 81° 02' 10" East to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 37.3981 acres (1,629,060 square feet), more or less.

2013 ANNEXATION AREA B

thence S 00 degrees 44 minutes 32 seconds E, along the easterly line of Section 21, for a distance of 810.63 feet to a point; thence run S 89 degrees 58 minutes 54 seconds W for a distance of 2411.75 feet to an iron pin on the easterly right-of-way of Livingston Road; thence run northwesterly, along said right-of-way and the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 532.96 feet, a delta angle of 22 degrees 15 minutes 54 seconds, a chord bearing of N 29 degrees 31 minutes 51 seconds W, a chord length of 205.81 feet, and an arc length of 207.11 feet, for a distance of 207.11 feet to a point; thence run N 18 degrees 23 minutes 55 seconds W, along said easterly right-of-way, for a distance of 301.27 feet to a point; thence run N 17 degrees 45 minutes 56 seconds W, along said easterly right-of-way, for a distance of 184.51 feet to a point; thence run northwesterly, along said right-of-way and the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1710.00 feet, a delta angle of 23 degrees 00 minutes 07 seconds, a chord bearing of N 06 degrees 15 minutes 53 seconds W, a chord length of 681.90 feet, and an arc length of 686.50 feet, for a distance of 686.50 feet to a point; thence run N 05 degrees 14 minutes 11 seconds E, along said easterly right-of-way, for a distance of 1134.19 feet to an iron pin on the northerly line of Section 21; thence run N 89 degrees 43 minutes 16 seconds E, along the northerly line of said Section 21, for a distance of 2610.95 feet to the northeast corner of said Section 21; thence run S 00 degrees 44 minutes 32 seconds E, along the easterly line of said Section 21, for a distance of 398.48 feet to a point; thence run S 67 degrees 14 minutes 42 seconds E for a distance of 313.83 feet to a point; thence run southeasterly along the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 500 feet, a chord bearing of S 34 degrees 19 minutes 21 seconds E, and a chord length of 188.40 feet; thence run S 64 degrees 31 minutes 58 seconds E for a distance of 301.19 feet to a point on the easterly line of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of Section 22; thence run S 00 degrees 44 minutes 32 seconds E, along said easterly line of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the West 1/2 of Section 22, for a distance of 834.39 feet to a point on the northerly line of said Bridgewater Ten; thence run S 89 degrees 08 minutes 16 seconds W, along said northerly line, for a distance of 663.63 feet to the Point of Beginning. Beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 33, Township 7 North, Range 2 East, Madison County, Mississippi, and run THENCE North along the East line of Section 33, Township 7 North, Range 2 East a distance of 1,463 feet to a point; run THENCE North

- (c) Said services shall be furnished in the same manner as such services are being furnished to the present citizens of the municipality where necessary and economically feasible and legally permissible.

SECTION 4. That the City of Ridgeland shall furnish to the said annexed territory the following municipal and public services in the same manner and to the same extent as such services are being furnished to the present citizens of the municipality, such services being on the effective date of this Ordinance, to-wit:

- a) Police Protection;
- b) Planning and Zoning;
- c) Fire Protection;
- d) Garbage removal;
- e) Trash and other debris removal;
- f) Pest control;
- g) Animal Control;
- h) Maintenance of existing streets, rights of way and drainage structures and facilities;
- i) Code enforcement;
- j) Parks and recreation service; and
- k) The right to exercise the ballot in municipal elections upon registering and meeting all statutory and constitutional requirements and upon proper approval of the changes created by this Ordinance under the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and the use and benefit of all other municipal services and facilities furnished by the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi to all of the present citizens of the municipality.

SECTION 5. The City of Ridgeland, Mississippi, through its attorneys, shall file a

petition in the Chancery Court of Madison County, Mississippi, which petition shall recite the fact of the adoption of this Ordinance and shall pray for the approval, ratification and confirmation by the said Court of the enlargement and extension of the municipal boundaries and limits of the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi as herein fixed and determined. Said petition shall have attached thereto a certified copy of this Ordinance and a plat or map showing the boundaries of the said City of Ridgeland, Mississippi, as they will exist in the event such enlargement and extension becomes effective pursuant to this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of the entry of the Decree of the Chancery Court of Madison County, Mississippi, ratifying, approving and confirming the enlargement and extension of the boundaries of the City of Ridgeland, Mississippi as established by this Ordinance and Decree of said Chancery Court.

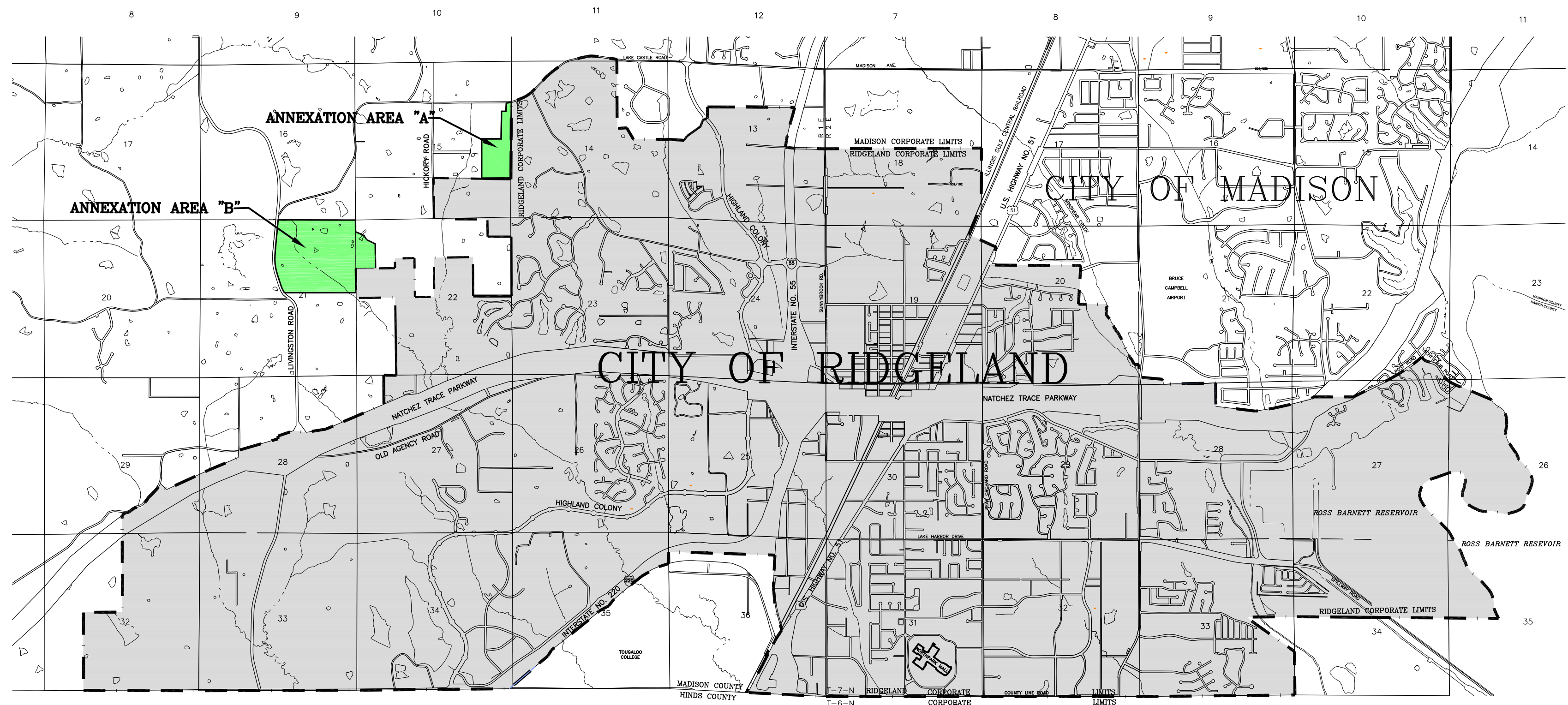
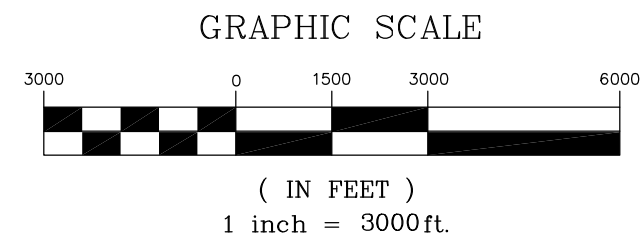

**PETITION TO CLOSE AND VACATE A CERTAIN UNIMPROVED AND

OF THE MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, AS AMENDED**

COMES NOW, Mississippi Methodist Hospital and Rehabilitation Center, Inc. (hereinafter "MMRC" or "Petitioner"), and files this, its *Petition to Close and Vacate a Certain Unimproved and Unused Street and Right-of-Way as platted in the Village or Town of Ridgeland*, pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 21-37-7 (1972), and in support thereof would show as follows, to-wit:

1.

Mississippi Methodist Hospital and Rehabilitation Center, Inc. owns certain property which abuts, joins and is adjacent to a certain unimproved and unused street and right-of-way as platted in the Village or Town of Ridgeland, which is unimproved and is not being used for public purpose. This street and right-of-way, being a portion of Hamilton Street, is more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land also known as the Hamilton Street right-of-way situated in Block 47 of the Village or Town of Ridgeland, a subdivision, the map or plat of which is recorded in the Chancery Records of Madison County at Canton, Mississippi, and being further described as part of the said Block 47 and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the southwest corner of Lot 16 of Block 47, said southwest corner being the **POINT OF BEGINNING** for the parcel herein described; thence South

89° 54' 29" East for a distance of 380.00 feet along the southern line of Lots 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 to the southeast corner of Lot 22; thence run South 00° 05' 31" West for a distance of 60.00 feet along the western right-of-way line of South Maple Street; thence North 89° 54' 29" West for a distance of 380.00 feet along the southern right-of line of Hamilton Street to a point intersecting the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street; thence North 00° 05' 31" East for a distance of 60.00 feet along the said eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.523416 acres (22,800 square feet), more or less.

A plat showing Block 47 of the City of Ridgeland and that portion of Hamilton Street to be closed and vacated is attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and said Exhibit is incorporated into this Petition by reference as if fully copied herein.

2.

The above described street and right-of-way is not being used and has never been improved, said street and right-of-way is not required by public convenience and necessary for a municipal street, and is not necessary for any municipal purpose whatsoever. It is in the best interest of the City of Ridgeland, its citizens and the Petitioner that this street and right-of-way, being the described portion of Hamilton Street, be closed and vacated.

3.

Petitioner is the owner of a portion of the platted street and right-of-way described at Paragraph 1 (the north half of Hamilton Street). The United States of America, represented herein by The National Park Service (hereinafter the "The Park Service"), is the owner of the remaining portion of the street and right-of-way, as described at Paragraph 1(the south half of Hamilton Street). A Certificate of Ownership is attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** and said Exhibit is incorporated into this Petition by reference as if fully copied herein.

The street and right-of-way described in Paragraph 1 runs adjacent to property owned by Petitioner and the abutting landowner, The Park Service, who has joined in this Petition and supports the requested relief. Specific ownership of the street and right-of-way is more particularly described as follows:

- (a) **MMRC**: A portion of the parcel of land also known as the Hamilton Street right-of-way situated in Block 47 of the Village or Town of Ridgeland, a subdivision, the map or plat of which is recorded in the Chancery Records of Madison County at Canton, Mississippi, and being further described as part of the said Block 47 and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the southwest corner of Lot 16 of Block 47, said southwest corner being the **POINT OF BEGINNING** for the parcel herein described; thence run South 89° 54' 29" East for a distance of 380.00 feet along the southern line of Lots 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 to the southeast corner of Lot 22; thence run South 00° 05' 31" West for a distance of 30.00 feet to northern line of the Natchez Trace Parkway right-of-way; thence run North 89° 54' 29" West for a distance of 380.00 feet to a point intersecting the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street; thence run North 00° 05' 31" East for a distance of 30.00 feet along the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.261708 acres (11,400 square feet), more or less.

- (b) **The Park Service**: A portion of the parcel of land also known as the Hamilton Street right-of-way reserved unto the City of Ridgeland in that certain Correction Warranty Deed dated August 23, 1961 between the State of Mississippi, as grantor, and the United States of America, as grantee, being recorded at Book 84, Page 85 in the office of the Chancery Clerk of Madison County, Mississippi, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Commence at the southwest corner of the said Lot 16 of Block 47 and thence run South 00° 05' 31" West for a distance of 30.00 feet along the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, thence run South 89° 54' 29" East for a distance of 380.00 feet along the northern line of the Natchez Trace Parkway right-of-way to a point intersecting the western right-of-way line of South Maple Street; thence run South 00° 05' 31" West for a distance of 30.00 feet; thence run North 89° 54' 29" West for a distance of 380.00 feet to a point intersecting the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street; thence run North 00° 05' 31" East for a distance of 30.00 feet along the eastern right-of-way line of South Perkins Street to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.261708 acres (11,400 square feet), more or less.

Petitioner, MMRC, and The Park Service waive just compensation or damage they may sustain from the closing and vacating of this unimproved and unused street and right-of-way as platted in the Village or Town of Ridgeland, and as described in this Petition.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Petitioner prays that this Petition be received by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Ridgeland, and that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen hold a hearing on this Petition and that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen close and vacate this unimproved and unused street and right-of-way, being that certain portion of Hamilton Street, as platted in the Village or Town of Ridgeland, and as described in this Petition.

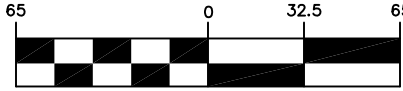
