The Mayor opened the January 4, 2022 meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to order. Present were Alderman Chuck Gautier, Alderman Wesley Hamlin, Alderman Ken Heard, Alderman Kevin Holder, Alderman D.I. Smith, Alderman Bill Lee, City Attorney Jerry Mills, City Attorney John Scanlon and City Clerk Paula Tierce. Absent was Alderman Brian Ramsey. The meeting was opened with an invocation by Alderman Wesley Hamlin followed by the pledge of allegiance.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen were provided a copy of the City Attorney's statement for services through December 28, 2021.

Next came the recognition of Sergeant Sara Perkins for being selected the 2021 First Responder of the Year by the First Responders of Mississippi. Mayor McGee announced that Sergeant Perkins was the initial responding officer to a shooting where a subject sustained a life-threatening injury to his arm after being shot while driving on a Ridgeland street. The subject was located lying on the side of I55 with major blood loss. Sergeant Perkins was one of the first officers to reach the subject and directed medical care, to include application of a tourniquet to the injured area, which saved the subject's life. Sergeant Perkins directed other officers on her shift to various crime scenes, identified areas for evidence collection and supervised a massive crime scene while maintaining emotional control. Approximately three weeks later, Sergeant Perkins was one of the first responding officers to arrive on a homicide scene where a 15 year old victim had sustained multiple gunshot wounds. The exemplary leadership displayed by Sergeant Perkins in overseeing the logistical deployment of available personnel, securing of the crime scene, relaying vital information to superiors, and communicating with witnesses on the scene led to the identity of the previously unidentified victim. Sergeant Perkins obtained information from bystanders and vetted it for relevance in the case, subsequently relaying it to investigators who made an arrest within four hours of the homicide. Two additional responses to motor vehicle crash scenes afforded Sergeant Perkins the opportunity to extract crash victims from damaged cars prior to the arrival of EMS and Fire Department personnel. Each of these motor vehicle crashes had victims who were trapped in the vehicle and needed immediate help in being extricated. Mayor McGee thanked Sergeant Perkins for her hard work and dedication to the City of Ridgeland.

Next came the matter of accepting the Minutes of the December 20, 2021 Work Session and the December 21, 2021 Board of Aldermen meeting. The Minutes were accepted with no corrections noted.

Alan Hart, Public Works Director/Community Development Director, made a presentation with regard to horses being maintained at 300 Hillview Drive on a plot of land less than the required acreage per the adopted ordinance. Jim Crews, the attorney for Stacy Sinuefield, then made a presentation and offered documents, which are attached hereto as Exhibit "C". The Mayor then closed the public hearing.

16. The conditions and circumstances which have caused this request are not the result of actions of the Petitioner, but result from:

THE PERIMETER OF PROPERTY & ESTABLISH ADEQUATE
RETENTION AREA.

No special privilege will be granted to the Petitioner by the approval of this dimensional variance which is not enjoyed by other property owners within this use district classification (zoning district). Other properties which enjoy the requested dimensions within the same zoning district are:

Petitioner believes that the reasons set forth in this Petition justify the granting of the variance, and the requested variance constitutes the minimum allowable deviation from the dimensional requirements of the Zoning Ordinance, while at the same time allowing for responsible use of the property as:

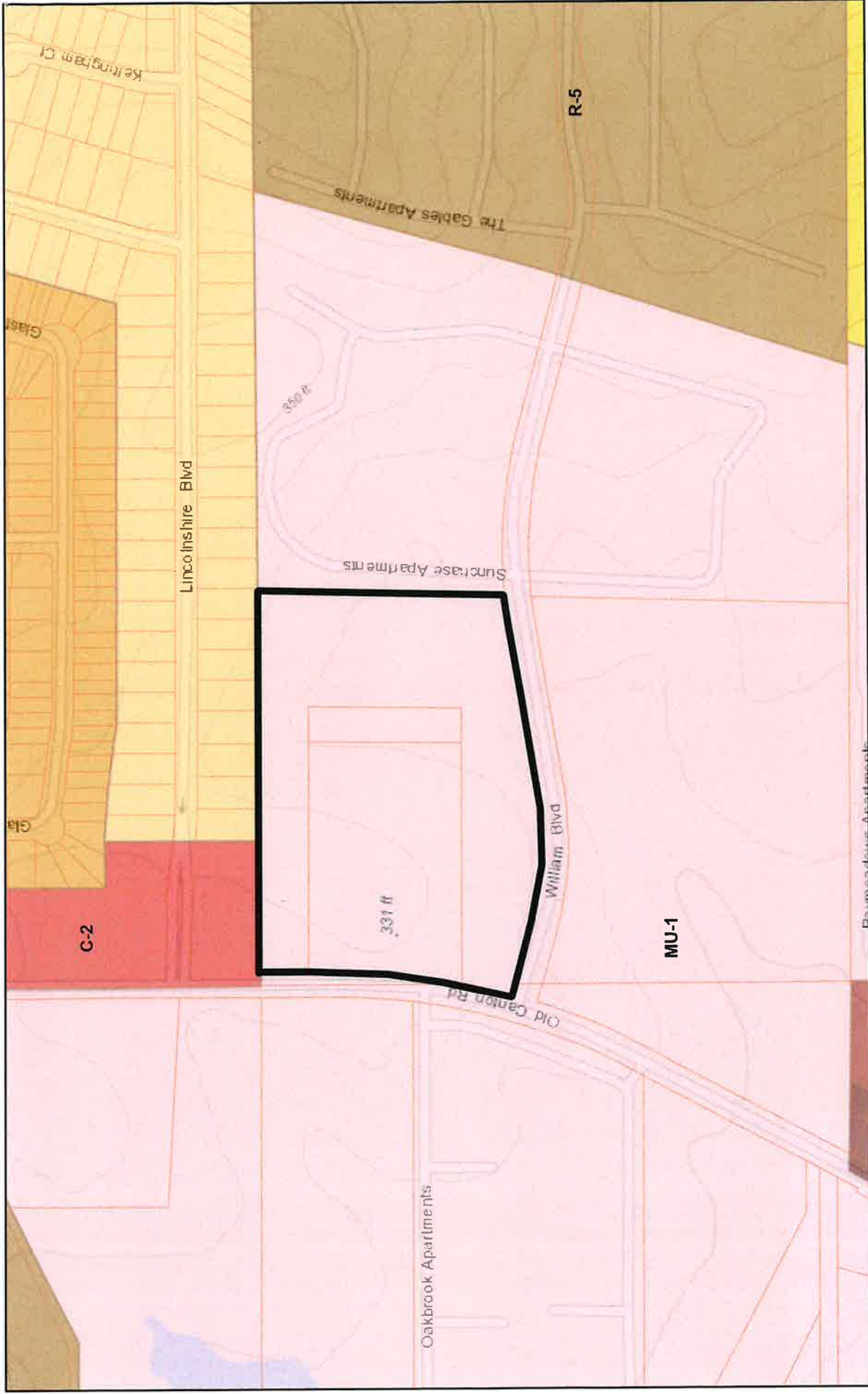

RE: Administrative interpretation and determination regarding Conditional Uses in MU-1 Zoning:

Interpretation:

As Director of Public Works, and pursuant to f Section 600.04.B, it is my duty to make administrative interpretations and determinations in the event there is a question as to the general intent or specific meaning of any provisions of the Zoning Ordinance text. The Mixed Use (MU-1) Zoning District was created with the intent to provide development opportunities for commercial, residential, and mixed-use developments. While the district encourages mixed-use developments it is not always practical to incorporate both commercial and residential uses on a specific property/lot.

At the regularly scheduled Mayor and Board of Aldermen meeting on December 12, 2021, the Mayor and Board discussed the Sartain proposal and found that it met the requirements of the Zoning Ordinance and approved the petition. The Mayor and Board appreciated the points raised by the Zoning Board and asked me to provide clarity in the form of an interpretation.

Therefore, it is my interpretation, that under the current Zoning Ordinance, Conditional Uses listed in MU-1 Zoning are permitted to apply for a Conditional Use Permit without being required to be part of a mixed-use development. The residential uses listed as a Conditional Uses in MU-1, and not part of a mixed-use development, shall follow the dimensional requirements for that residential district provided in the Zoning Ordinance:

- Detached, Single-Family Residential – R-2 Dimensional Requirements
- Zero lot line dwelling – R-4 Dimensional Requirements

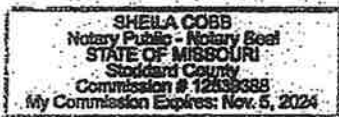

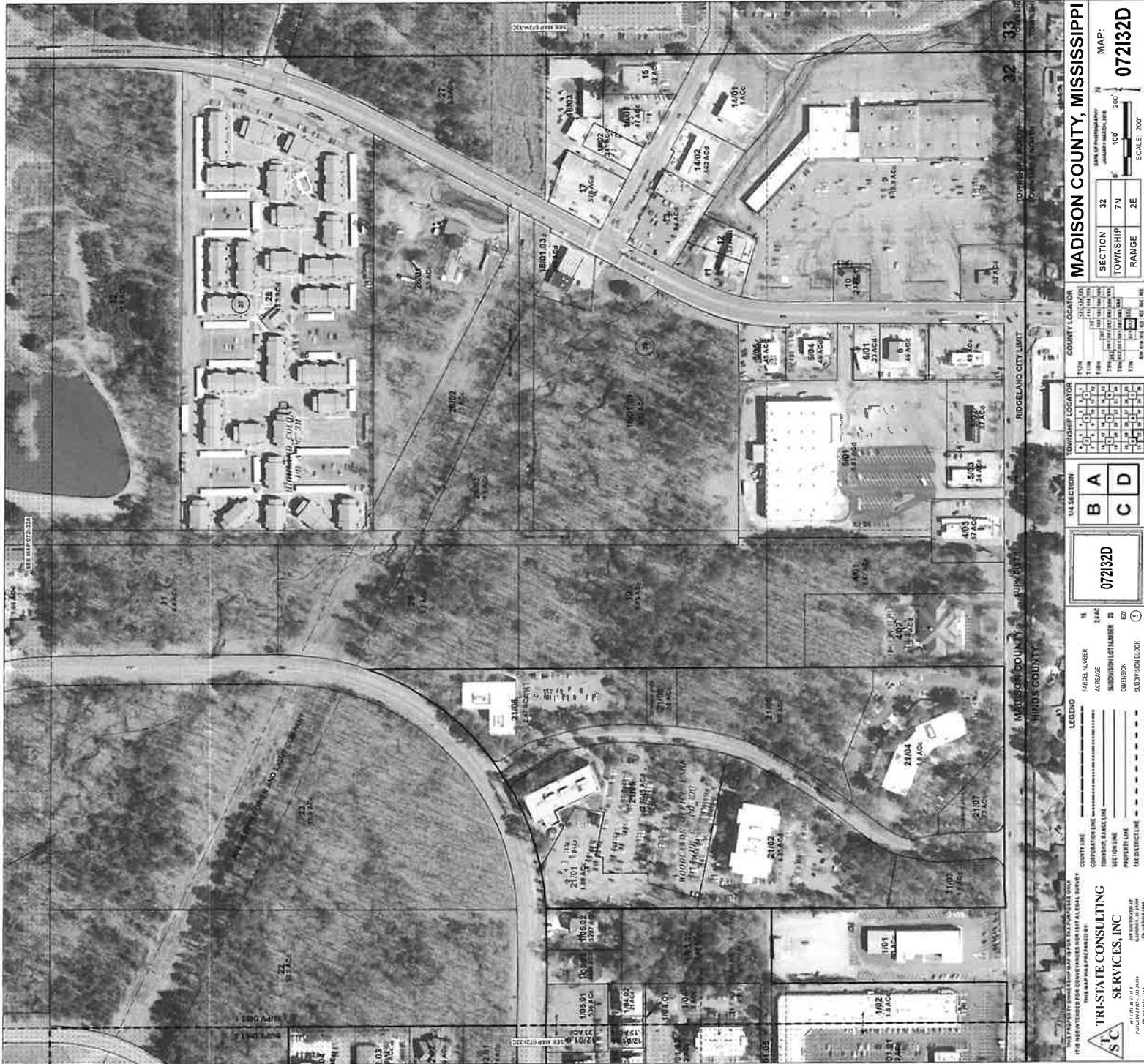

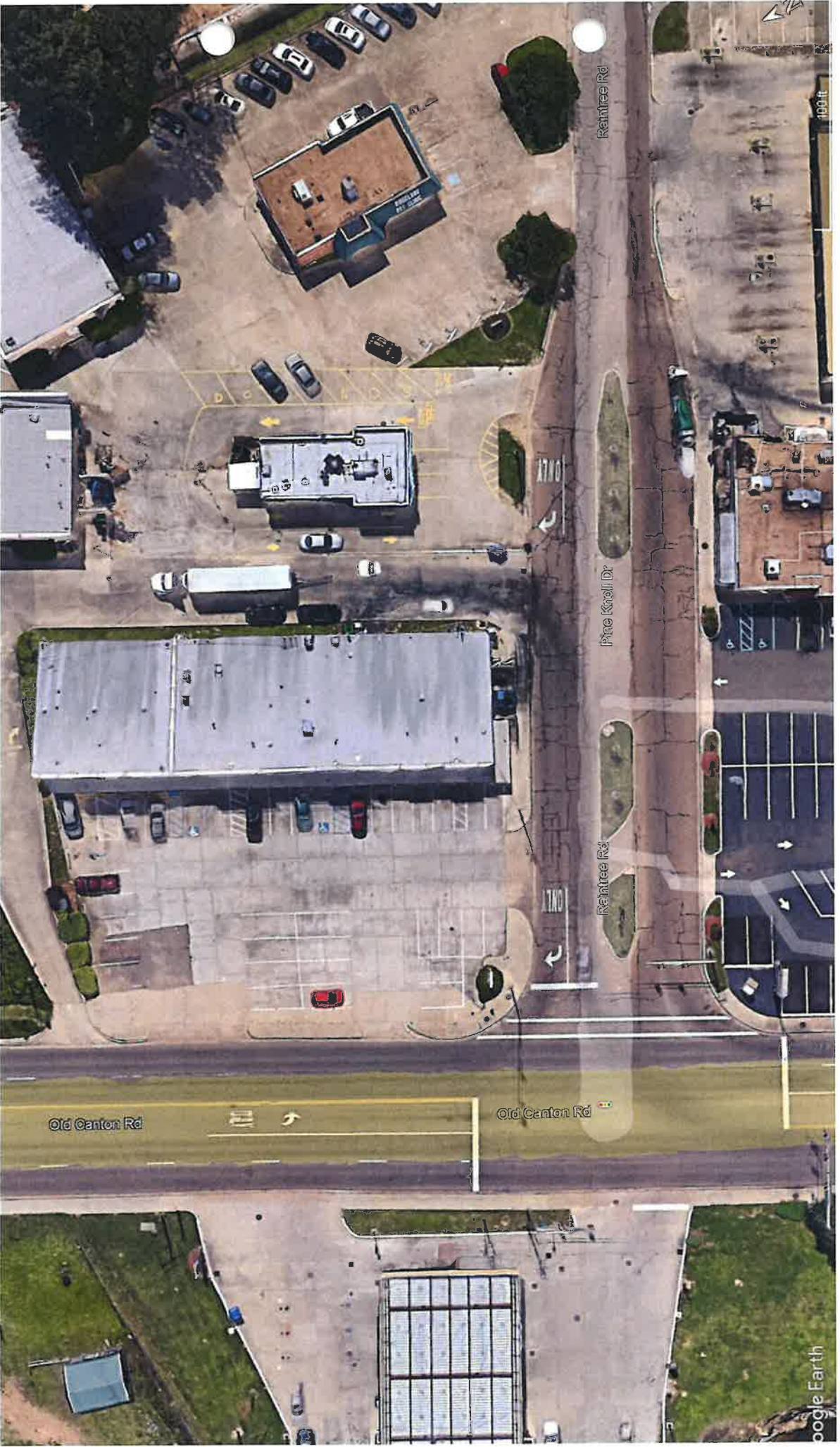

Interpretation:

As Director of Public Works, and pursuant to f Section 600.04.B, it is my duty to make administrative interpretations and determinations in the event there is a question as to the general intent or specific meaning of any provisions of the Zoning Ordinance text. The Mixed Use (MU-1) Zoning District was created with the intent to provide development opportunities for commercial, residential, and mixed-use developments. While the district encourages mixed-use developments it is not always practical to incorporate both commercial and residential uses on a specific property/lot.

At the regularly scheduled Mayor and Board of Aldermen meeting on December 12, 2021, the Mayor and Board discussed the Sartain proposal and found that it met the requirements of the Zoning Ordinance and approved the petition. The Mayor and Board appreciated the points raised by the Zoning Board and asked me to provide clarity in the form of an interpretation.

Therefore, it is my interpretation, that under the current Zoning Ordinance, Conditional Uses listed in MU-1 Zoning are permitted to apply for a Conditional Use Permit without being required to be part of a mixed-use development. The residential uses listed as a Conditional Uses in MU-1, and not part of a mixed-use development, shall follow the dimensional requirements for that residential district provided in the Zoning Ordinance:

- Detached, Single-Family Residential – R-2 Dimensional Requirements
- Zero lot line dwelling – R-4 Dimensional Requirements

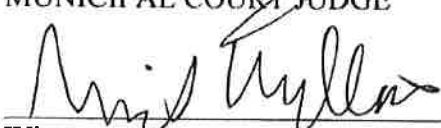

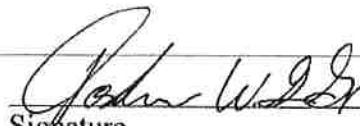

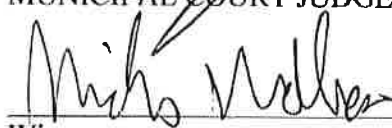
